## **New Faculty Program Collaboration Grant**

Deadline: January 16, 2019

The IAH Collaboration Grant is its second year and provides funding to a participant of the New Faculty Program who collaborates with a more senior faculty member. Proposals for research projects that lead to a publication, creative activity, or a grant proposal will be prioritized. **The program has a total of \$5,000 and we may provide one or more grants depending on the quality and quantity of proposals.**

ELIGIBILITY: The new faculty member should be the lead on the project. The funds can be used to pay for a graduate research assistant, travel to conduct research, supplies and materials to conduct research, or other research related activities. The funds cannot be used to support faculty salaries. **Funds must be spent by December 31, 2019.** Priority will be given to collaborations outside the home department and that lead to new faculty advancing their careers in their respective fields.
