Summer International Collaborative Research Grant

Grant description and application components

The Institute for the Arts and Humanities invites proposals from faculty at the rank of associate professor in the fine arts and humanities with a primary appointment in the College of Arts and Sciences for the Summer International Collaborative Research Grant. This grant will provide \$20,000 of ongoing funding for up to five years for international projects beginning in summer 2023. Faculty may use the funds to travel abroad and establish new collaborative research projects or continue existing ones. Two grants will be awarded. These funds will expire on June 30, 2028.

- Preference will be given to proposals for projects with one of UNC's four strategic partners, King's College London, Universität Tübingen, National University of Singapore, and Universidad San Francisco de Quito.
- Proposals for new or existing collaborative research projects with a host organization, such as a university, museum, think tank, or consortium will also be considered.
- Research products should be detailed in the proposal, with an explanation for why a given product is important to the recipient's field or professional development.

Please note the following components of the application as you may wish to draft them in a word processor prior to proceeding with the application.

- 1. Narrative proposal that explains the importance of international collaborative research for this project, its potential for elevating the applicant's international reputation in their field, and the kinds of anticipated research outputs resulting from this project (1000 words max.)
- 2. Work plan with activities beginning in summer 2023 and continuing through subsequent time periods as necessary for the collaborative project (one-page)
- 3. CV
- 4. Proposed budget

Research funds may be used to pay for the following:

- Up to \$5,000 on summer salary, including fringe, taken during the summer of 2023
- International and local travel
- Lodging and meals (based on the local cost of living)
- Books and supplies, including archival research, reproductions, and research equipment
- Funding UNC graduate research assistants, including travel
- Hosting, catering, and venue rental for international events, conferences, or symposia held at UNC –
 Chapel Hill
- Honoraria, speaker fees, and consulting fees for services provided in the United States
- Professional development activities for related conference registration fees and/or membership fees for international scholarly organizations
